

DIGITAL LITERACY TIP

- 1. Always make sure the website you're visiting is safe. (Look for the lock at the beginning of the webpage URL link)
- 2. Never share personal information online (ex. SSN, DOB, ATM pins)
- 3. Don't click on unknown "Download" buttons, or too good to be true deals.
- 4. When creating a password make sure it has at least 10 characters and they're a mix of uppercase and lowercase letters, numbers, and symbols.
- 5. Always add a phone number to your email account so that password recovery is easy.
- 6. Keep your passwords safe.
- 7. Never buy online at unknown websites.

TECH TIP

Always keep drinks away from your computers. What to do if by accident you spilled liquid onto your PC/Laptop?

Often we need that coffee to help finish that project. In the urgency of the moment, we make a move, or a cat jumps, and our secret potion ends up on our computer. At LFC, we see this on almost a daily basis. Here are a few tips on what to do:

- 1. To avoid personal injury, make sure you're not in contact with water.
- 2. Turn off and unplug your computer right away; This will avoid a short circuit that may cause permanent damage.
- 3. If the battery in the computer is accessible, remove it immediately. If not, follow the next steps.
- 4. Disconnect any USB, Dongle, or other items connected to your computer.
- 5. Turn the computer upside down for the water to flow out. If it is a laptop, turn it upside down in a V Shape.
- 6. Wipe any excess water on the surface of the computer near any ports or openings. Leave it like that for at least 24 hours or as long as necessary to ensure it is water-free.
- 7. Once confident, you can turn the computer on again.
- 8. Take it to a repair shop to be checked. If under warranty, take it to the store.
- 9. In the future, avoid food and drinks near your computer. Avoid leaving your computer where it can be reached by children and/or common places such as a dining table.
